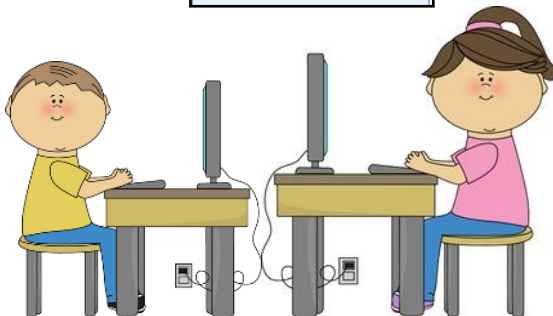


In Year Three, we love to use technology to enhance our learning experiences through exploring Word, Powerpoint, programming (Scratch), animation work and searching safely on the Internet.

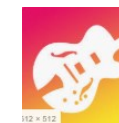
