At St Thomas' CE Primary Academy, we aim to help all children to benefit as fully as possible from their education. Children work mainly within their own class, receiving high levels of first quality teaching, participating in intervention groups, and accessing 1:1 support where appropriate.

Arrangements are made for pupils who have medical conditions so that they can access all areas of the curriculum through individual support, adaptations, or modifications to all school-based activities. Children with an EHCP will have tailored support provided to ensure that all their needs are met (SEND Information Report and SEND Policy).
