What is the role of the Church School Council?

Our Church School Council members have a very important role within our school. They have many responsibilities and act as positive role models, demonstrating the high expectations for behaviour we have in school. The team is made up of 2 elected representatives from each year group (one from each class in Y2-5). There will also be a Chairperson, Vice-chair, Treasurer and a secretary (Y6).

Here are just some of the roles that they have:

- Share the voice of the rest of the school,
- Show visitors around,
- Monitor classroom reflective areas,
- Monitor class CW logs and give feedback to classes,
- Lead collective worships,
- Be the change!

Election Process

- If you would like to put your name forward to be a member, you need to tell your teacher before the end of the day.
- Next week, you will get the chance to tell the rest of your class why you should be chosen as a representative.
- You need to prepare a poster and a speech to explain to your class why you should be chosen.
- Two children will be chosen from each class, via a class vote on Wednesday 30th October.
- These children will then be asked to complete an application form and submit it to Miss Clark by Tuesday 6th October. A specially chosen panel will then carefully select our final members for our Church School council.

Once elected...

- We will meet regularly as a team throughout each term.
- The Church School Council will be writing a newsletter. So if you have some fantastic ideas to what should be included, don't forget to mention them on your application form.
- Minutes, which are taken in every meeting, will be shared by the class representative to the rest of the class. This a great chance to discuss any ideas you all have and want school council to discuss in the next meeting.
